Dress Code

Creative Dance, Preliminary Dance, and Elementary Dance

Children in Creative Dance, Pre-Dance and Elementary Dance classes wear Black leotards. If you choose to wear a skirt teachers recommend skirts that are attached to leotards. Tights are to be pink. For ballet classes, hair should be in a bun, in pony tails, or otherwise pulled back. Children should wear leather ballet slippers with elastics. Please do not purchase satin slippers, as they fall off easily.

Ballet and Pointe Attire

Ballet students should wear leotards of any color (black is preferred) and pink or tan tights. Skirts and Ballet shorts are permitted in some classes, however occasionally a student may be asked to remove them for proper alignment. Black tights, jazz pants, or cover ups of any kind are not permitted in classes since the instructors need to clearly see the body of the student. Please leave bracelets and jewelry at home. Instructors will ask students to remove any jewelry or excess attire. Hair should be in a secure ponytail or bun. Students with shorter hair should have their hair pinned back.

Ballet and Pointe Shoes

Students should have pink leather or canvas ballet slippers with elastics sewn properly. Any ribbons should be tucked inside the shoes. The student's name should be written inside the shoes. Pointe shoes must be fitted and sewn properly by a knowledgeable dance professional at a reputable dance store.

Jazz Attire and Shoes

Jazz students may wear any color leotard (black is preferred). Any color tight is permitted in this class. Properly hemmed jazz pants that do not touch the floor are permitted. Jazz students should wear soft black leather Jazz Boot (no laces). All new jazz shoes should be rubbed vigorously with a towel or scuffed on dark carpet before attending classes at PDC. Please do not walk outside in dance shoes - this damages the shoes and may subsequently damage the dance floors.

Hip-Hop Attire and Shoes

Hip-Hop students must wear the same attire as Jazz students (please see above) However, shorts and other fitted cover ups are permitted. Students should hip-hop jazz sneakers. No street sneakers. All new shoes should be rubbed vigorously with a towel or scuffed on dark carpet before attending classes at PDC. Please do not walk outside in dance shoes - this damages the shoes and may subsequently damage the dance floors.

Tap Attire and Shoes

Tap students must wear the same attire as Jazz students (please see above). We recommend Bloch Tap Boot. Children taking tap should wear black patent leather tap shoes. The ribbon must be replaced with elastic. Please do not walk outside in tap shoes - this damages the shoes and will subsequently damage the dance floors.

Contemporary Attire

Students dance barefoot, but white socks may occasionally be needed. Students may wear any color leotard. (Black is preferred). Any color tights, black jazz pants, or shorts are permitted for class because there is a great deal of floor work. Students' legs should be fully covered. At times, knee pads may be used for classes. Teachers will notify students if they should bring kneepads.

Labeling Attire and Shoes

All dance attire and shoes (ballet, jazz, hip-hop, tap shoes) should have the student's name clearly labeled inside. If shoes are left at PDC, we need to know who they belong to. Please take a moment to write your child's name in their shoes. Thank you.
